

## Online meeting needs for training courses

For online meetings Jitsi is used. This is a collection of open source projects which provide state-of-the-art video conferencing capabilities that are secure and easy to use.

It does not demand the installation of a specific program. Nor it is restricted to specific operating systems.

For participating in an online meeting, a **web browser** is used. Following browsers are supported:

## Join a online training course

After you have registered for a online training course and the minimum number of participants has been reached, you will receive a link to a Jitsi meeting.

1. If you have received such an invitation, mark the link and copy it into your browser's address bar. Then press the **Enter/Return** key.
2. Your browser may first ask you to grant microphone and/or camera access. If you trust the person who invited you, confirm this access request. Please refer to the browser's documentation for details (e.g. [Firefox](#), [Chrome](#)).
3. If prompted, enter a name, which will be visible to other participants in the Jitsi meeting.
4. (Optional) Adjust the camera and/or microphone settings via the v drop-down menu items.
5. Click on **Join meeting**.
