

RustDesk installation and set up

RustDesk is a remote access and remote control software, allowing maintenance of computers and other devices.

Main Features

- Fully secure with end-to-end encryption
- Send or receive any files with ease
- Two ways to communicate with your remote partner by text chat
- The free program is very easy to use

Download RustDesk for a Windows computer

Log in to the user account you normally use.



Supported operating systems: **Windows, macOS, Linux, (Android, iOS)**

License: free open source

Click on **DOWNLOAD** to start the download for newer Windows computers and save

the zip-file. By default the file is stored in the Download directory.

Install RustDesk on your Windows computer

Start the File Explorer by clicking the icon.  Go to the folder where the downloaded zip-file is stored and double click it.


Then double click on the rustdesk-exe file on the right side.

A new window is displayed. For easier use, the application needs to be installed first.

The installation enables RustDesk to work properly on your computer.

To start the installation, click on **Install**



In the new window, the predefined values are usually reasonable. However, it is possible to change these.

Click on **Accept and Install** to start the installation.

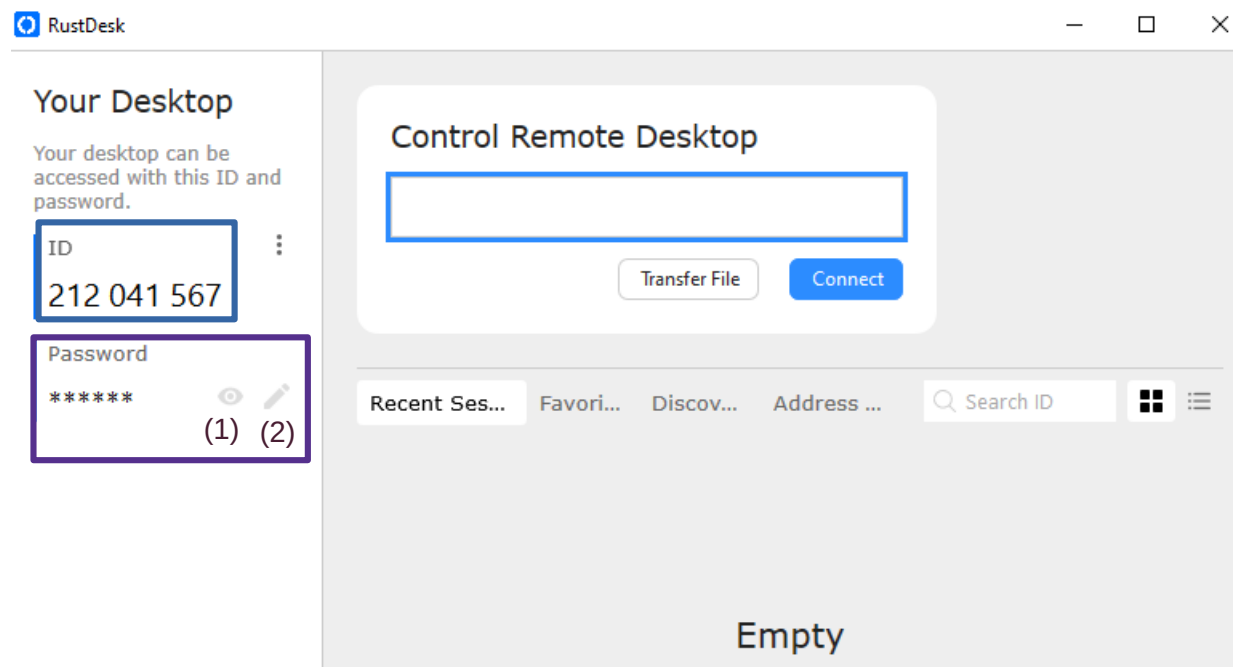

Make the program easier to use



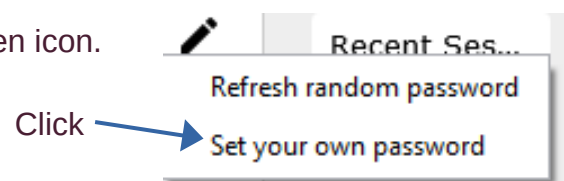
The ID is automatically generated by the program and should not be changed.

Set a static Password

Allowing a remote computer to connect to your PC, it needs to know the ID and password of your RustDesk program.

(1) By default, RustDesk generates a random password. When moving the cursor on the  icon, the password becomes visible.

(2) Set your own static password by clicking the pen icon.

Then click on **OK**

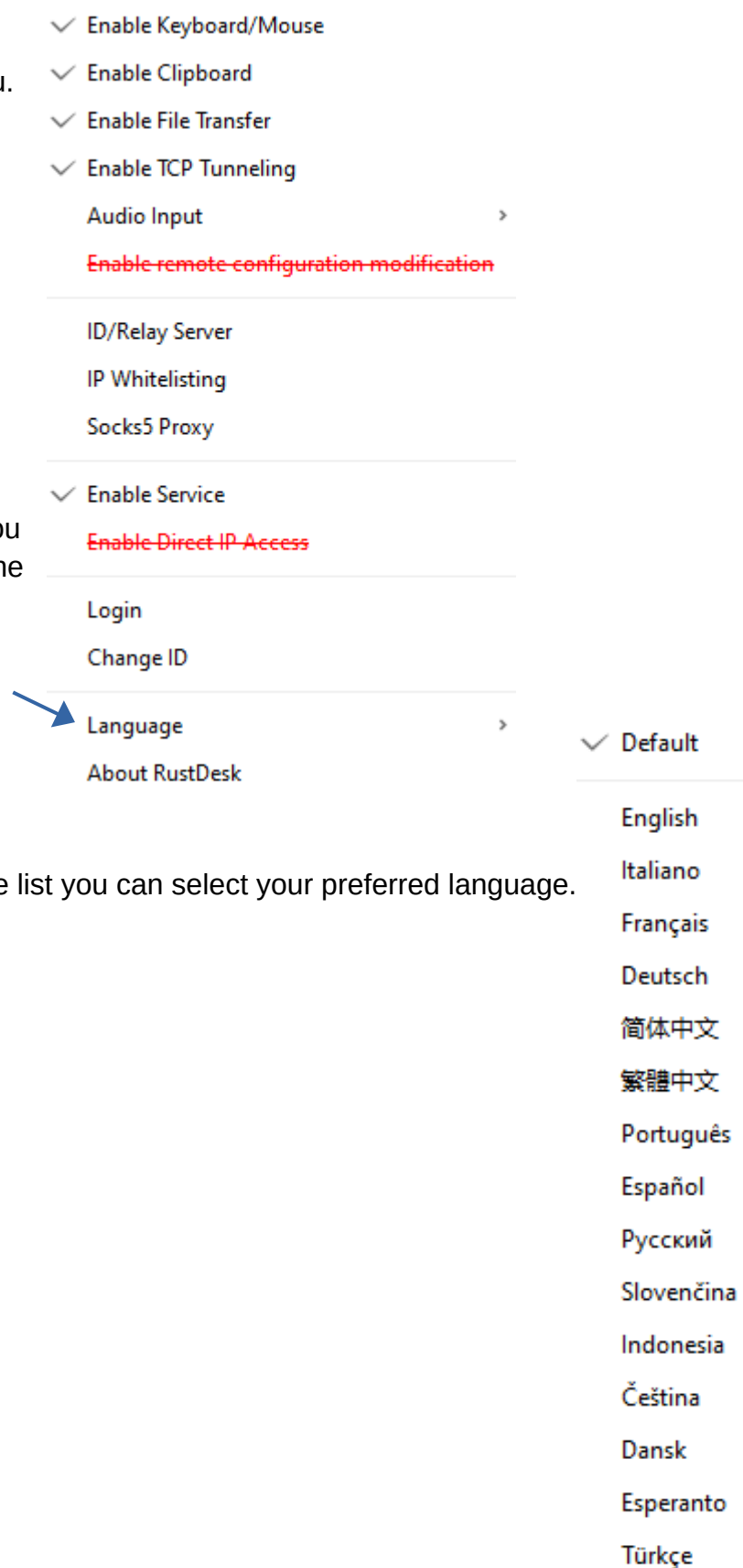
